Designs On Their Future

Students Carol Lewis and Andrea Byrne have designs for making a name for themselves in the world of fashion.

To demonstrate their flair for styling they created these Cubist outfits, which they modelled at the Textile Institute Conference in Southport yesterday. They were among 25 students from Liverpool Polytechnic's department of fashion and textiles taking part in the 40-minute fashion shows at the Prince of Wales Hotel. Among the outfits were a collection of students designs intended for show at the London Fashion Fair at Olympia. The final year students were asked by top designer Gay Ironmonger to design commercial woman's wear for select up-market stores which would be individual enough to extend through an entire winter season. They were told to base their research on the major Cubist exhibition at the Tate Gallery, and fabrics were donated by the textile Institute.
